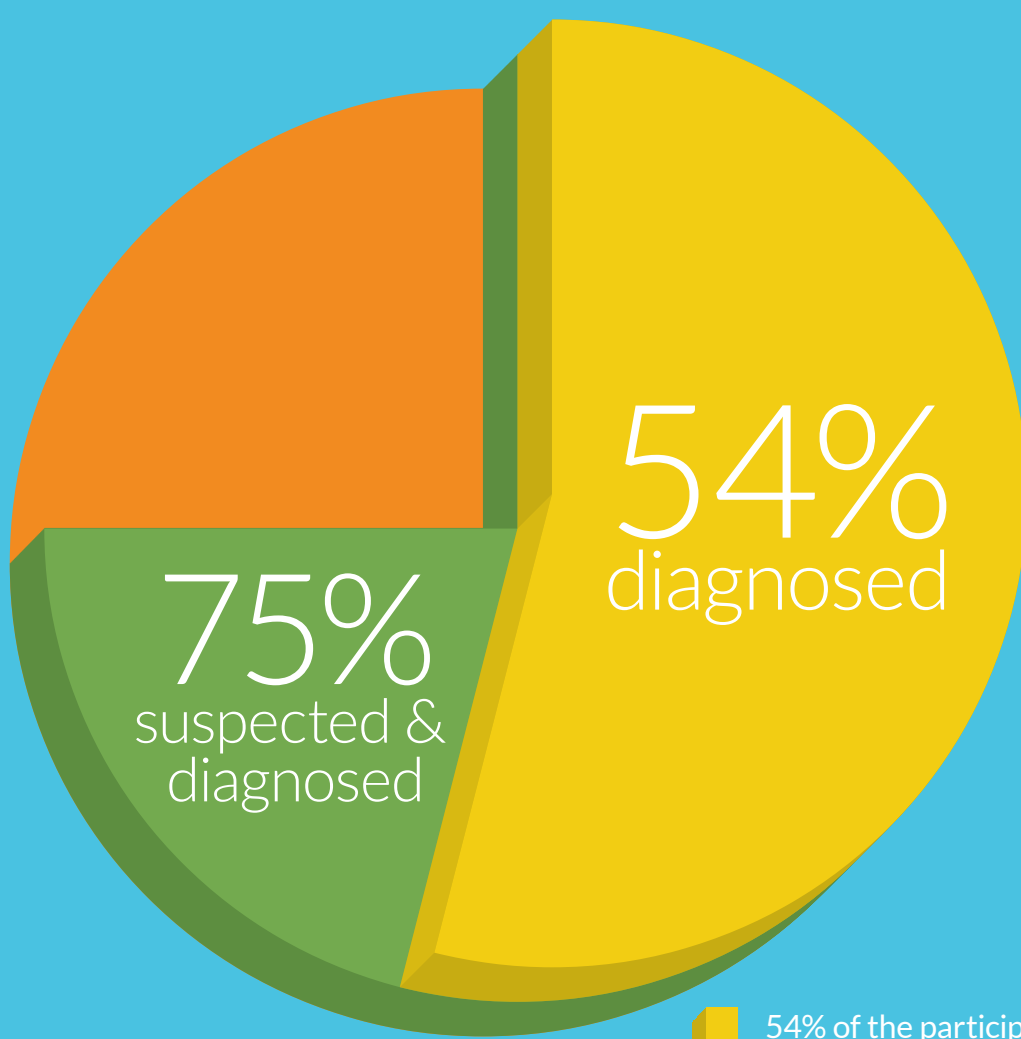


# Suicidality & Eating Disorders Among LGBTQ Youth 2018:

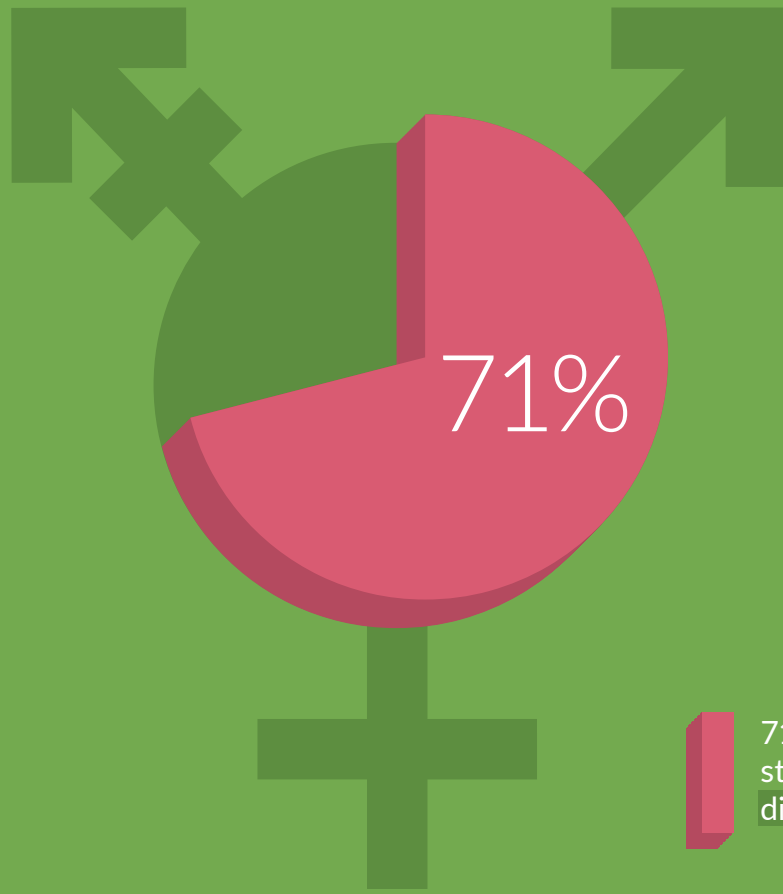
## A National Assessment



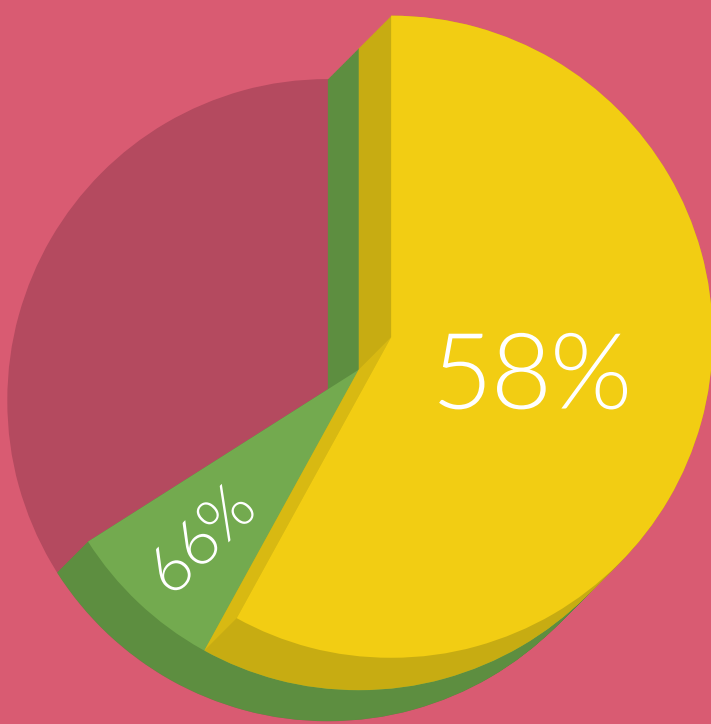
1,034 13-24-year-olds who self-identified as LGBTQ and resided in the United States participated in this survey.

54% of the participants indicated that they had ever been diagnosed with an eating disorder.

In addition to those diagnosed, an additional 21% (75% out of all respondents) suspected that they had an eating disorder.

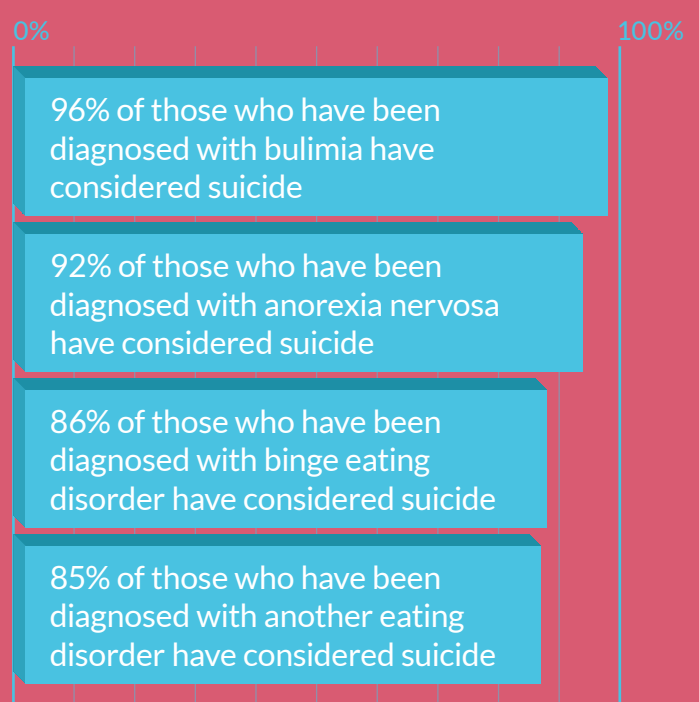


71% of transgender respondents who identify as straight have been diagnosed with an eating disorder, with anorexia being the most common

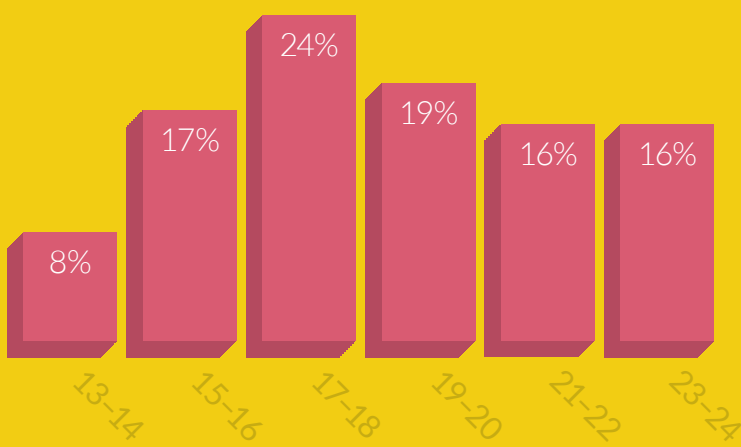


58% of those who have been diagnosed with an eating disorder have considered suicide.

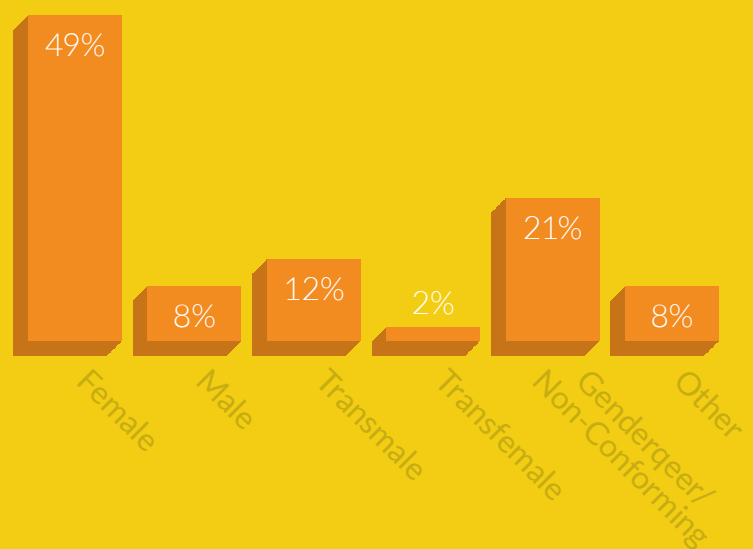
66% of those who have considered suicide have been diagnosed with an eating disorder.
